## **TIMELINE**

*Robert Parrish and Parrish Group, Inc.*

**1973** – Robert Parrish relocates to Tallahassee from Augusta, Georgia; works as a bartender while going to Tallahassee Community College then FSU

**1978** - Robert Parrish receives his Florida real estate license and later goes to work for Hartung & Associates (now Coldwell Banker Hartung & Noblin)

**1984** –Parrish receives his Florida Residential Contractor's License and establishes Parrish Builders, Inc.; he builds his first high end spec home on Noble Drive with another investor

**1984 through 1986** – The company builds 14 more homes in the same upscale neighborhood

**1987 through early 1990s** – Parrish Builders expands into Golden Eagle, SummerBrooke and Hawk's Nest

**1989** – Robert Parrish receives his Florida General Contractor's license and makes his first venture into commercial building with the SummerBrooke Country Club Clubhouse building

**1989** - Parrish Group converts movie theatre to state-of-the-art television studio for Florida News Channel (now WCTV)

**1994** – Robert Parrish serves as President for Habitat for Humanity Board of Directors, launches "Blitz Build," where buildings and subs donate their time to build a house in 24 hours (profiting Habitat)

**1995** - Robert Parrish creates a sister company, Parrish Builders & Development Corp. (now inactive)

**1995** – Robert Parrish receives his Private Pilot's License

**1997** – Robert Parrish receives his Florida Real Estate Brokers License and creates a sister company, Parrish Properties & Development Corp. (still active)

**1998** – Parrish Builders, Inc. (PBI) completes 22,500 sq. ft. of office - First American Title and 2282 Killlearn Center Blvd.

**1998** – Robert Parrish serves as a founding member of the Community Foundation of North Florida volunteer Board of Directors

- 1999** – PBI completes nearly 100,000 sq. ft. of office, including ACS and MGT of America
- 2000** – The company completes 95,000 sq. ft. of office, including 3 buildings in Centre Point business park
- 2000 to 2001** – Tallahassee Builders Association names Robert Parrish "Builder of the Year"
- 2001** – Parrish creates a parent company, Parrish Group, Inc.
- 2001** – Parrish finishes 4 office buildings and an office warehouse, a total of 78,000 sq. ft. of space
- 2001 to 2002** - Robert Parrish serves as Tallahassee Builders Association President
- 2002** – Parrish Group completes two large buildings, totaling 73,000 sq. ft., including Aderant North America, Inc., Killlearn Center Blvd.
- 2003** – Parrish Group completes 122,000 sq. ft. of space, including corporate headquarters for Hunt Insurance Group/HRH Inc., the Tallahassee Builders Association and Tallahassee offices of the Butler Pappas law firm, plus medical office for Tallahassee Primary Care Associates
- 2003 through 2006** – Robert Parrish serves on the Capital Regional Medical Center Board of Directors
- 2004** – Parrish Group introduces a new business park, Hermitage Office Park and completes Parrish Group corporate headquarters, located at the park entrance
- 2005** – Parrish completes 2 buildings, 40,000 sq. ft. total, plus an addition for the Gardner Wadsworth Duggar Bist & Wiener law firm
- 2006** – After spending four years acquiring 19 individual parcels, clearing title and permitting the land, Parrish Group introduces Regional Center, a 35-acre business park, and completes 61,000 sq. ft. of space, including the corporate offices of Florida Home Builders Insurance, Inc. (FHBI), Messer Capparello & Self law firm and James D.A. Holley, PA
- 2006**– Robert Parrish is recruited to serve on the Board of Directors for Birmingham, Alabama-based Superior Bank (formerly known as "The Bank"), as it expands service to Tallahassee
- 2007** – Parrish Group is on target to complete 33,000 sq. ft. of build-to-suit office space, is in the planning and design for balance of 300,000 sq. ft. in Regional Center, and has closed on 3 new lots in Metropolitan Corporate Center with the balance of the park under contract
- 2008** - Robert Parrish slated to serve as president of 20,000-member Florida Home Builders
